The Valley of Concord Scholarship program provides financial support for the continuing education of young men and women from the Masonic Families of New Hampshire.

Eligibility: The following criteria are used to determine the eligibility of applicants for the program:

- A currently enrolled student at an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university, and
- A minimum grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale, and any of the following:
- A spouse, child, grandchild or member of the Valley of Concord Scottish Rite, or a current member of a recognized NH Masonic body, (e.g. DeMolay, Rainbow, Lodge).
